
For flooring we take into account either the weight and the visible treatment of the pieces. There are several placement systems that we use, whose choice will depend on the security criteria required by the project.






ARISTON



Originally from Greece, its discreet and homogeneous design is perfect for interior decoration of walls, floors and countertops that seek to highlight the lighting of the room. It is a high quality material and one of the most used.

THASSOS



It is a fine-grained white dolomite marble characterized by its uniformity. Its almost snowy white recalls its Greek origin where it dazzles with the luminosity it brings. In short, it is a material of an extraordinary purity and contrast.

DOLOMITA



Being one of the oldest materials due to its geological origin, it is a very fine natural stone with an homogeneous whiteness broken by soft veins of grey color, resulting from impurities of clay, silt, sand and quartz.

NESTOS BEIGE



With its grey base with light beige and cream veins, it is a stone extracted in Greece and is especially good for outdoor use:

walls, countertops, mosaics, fountains, lining for swimming pools and stairs.

NESTOS WHITE



A white marble of high quality that can be sawed to the contrary with a very compact grey or pink linear veining, or in favor with a very nice and open shading. Ideal for floors and interiors.

NESTOS GREY



The Nestos grey marble is a natural stone with greyish tones. One of its main qualities is that it allows to create wide luminous and homogeneous surfaces forming spaces of great beauty.

MARMARA



Similar in color and veined to Spanish White Macael, it is characterized by a greyish white background with grey linear veins. Working the piece with a sawing to the contrary, you get a very original and unique veining in natural stones.

SIVEC



Originally from Greece, its very fine grain composition gives it a whiteness and homogeneous pattern have turned it into one of the most used stones in sculpture and classic decoration.

CREMA MARFIL CLASSIC



It is the most appreciated beige marble in the world due to the refinement of its tonalities and the discretion of its natural veins. It is extracted mainly in Monte El Coto, Pinoso (Alicante, Spain).

CREMA MARFIL EXTRA



A more homogeneous quality of the Ivory Cream. Its polished finish brings a high gloss to the stone and it has the advantage of enlarging the spaces visually and giving them a great luminosity.

CREMA MARFIL COMMERCIAL

BROWN VITA

CLASSIC WHITE ONYX




From ancient Egypt, this translucent natural stone has always been fashionable. Its delicate extraction process makes it a stone with a very limited and exclusive production.

WHITE ONYX



A more neutral version of the Classic Onyx, its drawing with barely veining and its yellow tones give a great luminous effect in its finish. Resulting in a simple, warm and elegant piece.

BLACK MARQUINA



This classic marble is characterized by its fine grain and its calcite veins. Extracted in the Basque Country, its irregular white veins contrast with the rest of the black base, giving it a velvety sensation.

VOLAKAS



Greek in origin, this natural stone of white color with veins in grey and brownish tones, has always been very common in sculptures thanks to its smoothness, homogeneity and high resistance to breakage.

EMPEROR




Its great resistance, variety, natural texture and chromatic richness make this material one of the most used in countertops, bathrooms and floors. It stands out for its dark tonality with lighter fine veins.

CALACATTA GOLD



Ideal for interiors and exteriors, this luxurious Italian material stands out for its gold-effect details with contrasting grey veins. It is one of the most appreciated marbles since ancient times.

A more reddish version of fashionable marble being a trend in recent years for its combination of white and burgundy veins.

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ARMANI BRONZE




It stands out for its aesthetic and its high resistance. The white veins crack the ocher background with subtle darker shades. Its finish creates a special lighting effect in any space.

KOSMUS




Kosmus is a marble coming from Brazil, it is a greyish black aged mirror whose silver reflections make it ideal for beautify interior spaces, providing a luminous and vibrant touch.

BLUE LEMURIAN



This granite is an authentic beauty thanks to its intense palette of colors by iridescent, a halfway between blue and intense black. The pearl becomes the protagonist in luxurious furniture and decorative environments.

SODALITA



Unique in its kind, it presents an intense blue and striped greys, crossed by white veins of feldspar. Sodalite is considered a luxury stone due to its difficult location in the deposits of Brazil, Russia and South Africa.

BLUE MACAUBA



This quartzite from Brazil is used mainly for coatings for interiors and flooring. It was originated by the crystallization of sandstones so it is a very consistent material.

ORANGE ONYX



This crystalline orange colour with a semiprecious background makes its aesthetics and tone of colour an ideal bet for the design of spaces. It is a very distinguished material between architects and designers when we talk about natural stone.

RED ONYX



This Mexican stone is distinguished by the veteran drawing in reddish and brown tones, that forms concentric rings throughout the entire board thanks to the inclusion of iron and manganese.

OROBIC ARABESCATO



Unparalleled intense mix of reddish, cream and greyish tones, with a black, rust and white veining with dramatic and wide movements. This stone elevates visually any project.

GREEN ONYX



The colour of the onyx is rarely uniform, so light and dark materials are alternated in the same field. It is very frequent find Brown veins or reddish brown spots, due to the presence of iron oxide.

LARISSA



It maintains a high value for its characteristic bright white background with marked black veins. White Larissa is found exclusively in some quarries near the Pietrasanta region in the Apuan Alps of Tuscany, Italy.







BLACK BAMBOO



This material allows you to create unique and exclusive environments that allow you to create works of art anywhere in the project, whether in kitchens, pavement or interior coatings.

FOREST GREEN



A really different marble, with a very marked marbled that combines the colours ochre, greens and earth tones. It is one of the materials that stands out in an environment with the beauty of nature.

RAIN FOREST GREEN





The Green Bamboo granite is a green colored rock and can be used mainly for countertops in kitchen and bathrooms. This natural stone is one of the most used the decorative options in its range of homes or businesses.

PINEAPPLE ONYX



Onyx of Mexican origin is a translucent yellowish white semiprecious stone, therefore one of the most sought after in the world market to create an environment of exclusivity or differentiation.

PETRIFIED WOOD



A combination of semiprecious materials such as amethyst, quartz of high purity, or fossilized woods agglutinated all with high quality epoxy resin, calibrated and polished. An unique decorative bet.

WILD AGATE



Agate is the stone of the good luck, security and balance. The descriptive term "wild" of this product denotes the most extravagant ranges of blue in this semiprecious stone.

CRYSTAL PINK



Its fine white veins contrast with the pink colour of the background. They break small details of red veining, adding warmth to this piece of natural stone. Perfect for interior and ornamental finishes.

VALENCIA CREAM



It is a Spanish natural stone (Barcheta-Valencia) of fine grain and cream colour with white and reddish veins. Due to its delicacy, it is only usable indoors. In addition, its soft and orange color makes it ideal for decoration.

BLUE BAY



This granite has a polished glossy finish that offers a fresh and lively appearance highly recommended for homes, as it highlights its bright blue colour and its natural shine. A nuance that reinforces the sunlight forming unique spaces.

FORTUNE



This marble is special for its characteristic drawing, imitating the grain and tone of the wood. With a warm and somber tone, it is perfect to highlight parts of the rooms in kitchens or bathrooms.





VULCANO RED



A material in which the details do not leave you indifferent. The general reddish tone is fragmented into curvilinear veins of yellows, whites and blacks; drawing a whole range of warm tones and creating a unique piece in each cut.

FANTASY ONYX





IRON RED



This quartzite stone is used in several types of applications and comes from Brazil. The impressive play of colours between reds, greys and blues is due to the primary state of oxidation of iron in natural rock.

DAMAS GRIS
